Anyone installing electrical wiring in a residence is required to comply with electrical Code rules to ensure safe and legal installation. If the installation will be inspected, (technically, all electrical installations, of any size, are required to be inspected) it must pass inspection, or the installer may need to rewire some of their job and pay for a re-inspection.

All service equipment and electrical panels shall have a clear area 30" wide and 36" deep in front. This clear area must extend from floor to ceiling with no intrusions from other equipment, cabinets, counters, appliances, pipes, etc. Panels are NOT allowed in clothes closets or bathrooms.

1 – for all the ground wires combined. 1 – for all the cable clamps combined (if any) 2 – for each device (switch or outlet-but not light fixtures) Multiply the total by 2 for 14-gauge wire and 2.25 for 12-gauge wire to get the minimum box size required in cubic inches.
